

DOG SWIM NOTES & RULES

On the last day of the swim season, we have our Annual Dog Swim during the last 30 minutes. Here's how it works:

- Dog Swim is for Members and their dogs only – NO GUESTS.
- Dog-owning families assemble outside the pool (at the ramp at after 5:30)
- **DOGS MUST BE LEASHED & MUST GET ALONG WITH OTHER DOGS/CHILDREN/ADULTS**
- All pool-swimming patrons exit the pool promptly at 5:30
- Once the pool is cleared, at approx. 5:45, members walk their **LEASHED** dogs into the pool and gather at the shallow end of the main pool
- Dogs can then be unleashed and can swim in the pool - **NO LEASHED DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE POOL**
- Members **MUST** keep all unleashed Dogs in their sight.
- Dogs should exit the pool by using the stairs at the shallow end of the main pool - members should be able to coax their dogs to use the stairs.
- Members **CANNOT** be in the water with their dogs - those that do enter the water will be asked to leave the pool
- Members **CANNOT** push their dogs into the water - those that do enter the water will be asked to leave the pool
- Members **CANNOT** take their dogs down the slide or off the diving boards (amazingly, this has been attempted) - those that do enter the water will be asked to leave the pool
- Members **CAN** toss tennis balls into the water for their dogs to retrieve
- Members **MUST** clean up after their dogs!!!!
- Members **MUST** use good judgment regarding their dogs' swimming abilities
